

GREETINGS FROM THE DIRECTOR

One year into our 2023 Strategic Master Plan, park district staff and the Park Board have been hard at work aligning resources with the plan's recommendations and public feedback as we strive to be community focused and a place where everyone belongs!

We have expanded the capacity of our summer camps and added new options to meet the growing demand for these services. New this year, the No Name Teen Camp will be relocated to Woodglenn Park to help free up space within Community Park for the anticipated expansion of Camp Summer Quest, which has experienced unprecedented growth three years in a row. Creation Academy Art Camp will be offered for a third year with a revamped curriculum and newly added weekly field trips. Staff are also excited to offer a brand-new youth sports camp to help accommodate the community demand. For our preschool aged children, Gentle Learning Summer Camp offers themed activities each week and a variety of corresponding activities. Beyond camps, the popular Summer Entertainment Series will include free concerts every Wednesday in July starting on July 3rd with the annual Village of Lisle coordinated fireworks display. We have a terrific lineup of bands, beverage options, and food trucks throughout the month, so plan to join us for some great mid-week fun.

I'm pleased to share information about a variety of upcoming park improvements. Most notably, Tate Woods Park will undergo a major renovation. The project plans include expanded parking, a new playground and picnic shelter, basketball court, six (6) pickleball courts, improved accessibility and more. I want to personally thank the dozens of park neighbors who shared their thoughts and opinions during

the planning phase last summer. This new park will truly reflect those it serves and inspire visitors for years to come!

In partnership with the Village of Lisle and with supplemental funding through State Representative Terra Costa Howard, a protective canopy will be constructed under the BNSF train tracks at the northeast corner of Community Park. This canopy will preserve access to the park and will serve as an impressive gateway into and out of this flagship site. Additionally, Beau Bien Park is also getting a new playground this summer, along with outdoor fitness stations.

Ongoing attention and improvements continue at Sea Lion Aquatic Park as it enters its 21st season. While operating expenses continue to escalate with an aging facility and increasing costs of labor and materials, we continue to prioritize a first-rate facility in every way.

Lastly, in order to provide the services offered within this program guide, we need summer employees! With employment opportunities ranging from a few hours a week to 40, we provide an employment culture of teamwork, mutual respect, personal responsibility, and rewarding outcomes – both personally and professionally. SWIM LESSONS - WAVE A & B

♥ Sea Lion Aquatic Park Main Pool | 1825 Short Street, Lisle

Wave A curriculum focuses on basic swim skills, water confidence, forward movement, and water safety skills. It includes Level 1 - Water Exploration, Level 2 - Primary Skills and Level 3 - Stroke Readiness. It is common for students to repeat levels in the Wave A program to master the skills in each level.

Wave B focuses on developing your child's swimming techniques and provides the foundation needed for competitive swimming. Wave A (or its equivalent) is a prerequisite. It includes Level 4 - Stroke Development, Level 5 - Stroke Refinement and Level 6 - Stroke Proficiency. Wave B participants must be comfortable in deep water. All Wave B classes are taught in water 4 feet or deeper.

SWIM LESSON LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS:

LEVEL 1 - Water Exploration: Orientation to an aquatic environment, supported floating and kicking on front and back, alternating arm action, and basic water safety rules.

LEVEL 2 - Primary Skills: Concentration on exploring deep water, front and back glides (unsupported), and safety practices. Additional focus on back crawl (at least 5 yards), as well as the ability for the child to turn over front to back and back to front.

LEVEL 3 - Stroke Readiness: Increase swimming skill competency with a goal to swim a short distance without breaks, fundamentals of elementary backstroke, exploring deep water, introduction of dives from the side of the pool, and treading water with secondary focus on practicing safety and rescue skills.

LEVEL 4 - Stroke Development: Develop confidence and competency in strokes beyond preceding levels with a goal to swim 25 yards without breaks. Introduction of breaststroke and sidestroke, deep-water bobbing, diving from the side of pool from stride and standing positions, and turns at the wall.

LEVEL 5 - Stroke Refinement: Continue refinement of front crawl, back crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke and sidestroke. Introduction of butterfly and surface dives, alternate breathing, swimming under water, and open turns on front and back. Swimming distance is further increased from Level 4.

LEVEL 6 - Stroke Proficiency: Develop maximum efficiency and endurance for strokes, flip turns, tuck and pike surface dives, alternative kicks for treading water, as well as introduction to approach stroke and throwing rescues. Swimmers should be ready for competitive swimming after the completion of this level.



The Park District strives to be environmentally friendly and practice sustainability within our parks and facilities. Our Parks Department facilitates a variety of initiatives to help achieve this. As examples, staff mulch each park with wood chips that they save from tree and brush removals. Additionally, four (Oak Hill, Abbeywood, Connelly, and Leask Lane) parks are categorized as pesticide-free where no traditional pesticides or herbicides are used. Staff also have turned some traditional turf areas into either native plant spaces or "no mow" zones. This has reduced a significant amount of labor and fuel (emissions) with not having to mow large areas every week.

Oak Regeneration Project

Staff also make efforts to plant native wildflowers and grasses throughout every park, which are grown in-house by our Naturalists. These native plants provide food and shelter for local wildlife and pollinators. The deep roots of these plants help slow erosion and improve water quality as storm water percolates through the soil. They also absorb lots of storm water, reducing the amount of run-off in the parks. Native plants are highly adaptable to our changing climate.

Furthermore, staff also spend significant time removing invasive species. In Community Park alone, staff recently removed honeysuckle, buckthorn, and mulberry trees from a half-acre plot. This area will now be replanted with native flowers and grasses, improving biodiversity and offering food and shelter to local wildlife.

As part of our ongoing Oak Regeneration project, staff have been collecting acorns from old oak trees in our parks to grow and then plant, which preserves local oaks in our parks. Staff also shifted tree planting strategies, planting much smaller trees than in the past. The traditional large trees at nurseries are balled and burlaped, and lose over 90% of their

roots in the transplanting process. These larger trees also require lots of water and take longer to become established. The smaller trees being implemented now are grown in bags and maintain almost all of their roots in the transplanting process. This allows them to become established quicker with less watering requirements. While staff still plant some traditional ornamental trees, we've shifted the majority of species we plant to trees that are native to Illinois.

These native trees are significantly more tolerant of changing weather conditions. Staff are proud to have received the 2022 Jane Foulser Habitat Award for undertaking this innovative, multi-year project of germinating hundreds of acorns and planting young oak trees throughout our parks in the next several years.

The Lisle Community Park Boat Launch is intended for use of personal non-motorized boats or floating vessels, such as kayaks, canoes, and paddle boards. Please abide by the following rules:

- Consider your ability and weather conditions before embarking.
- Let others know of your boating plans and paddle with others for safety reasons, don't do it alone.
- Always wear a life vest and carry a whistle to alert others in an emergency.
- Don't paddle during flood conditions or after heavy rain.
- Dress for cold weather and pack extra clothes.
- Avoid fallen trees/branches or other obstructions in the water.
- Carry around all dams even low dams are dangerous.



We have three shelters available to rent in Community Park. We also offer park rentals at Beau Bien, Leask Lane, Peach Creek, Surrey Ridge, and Woodglenn parks. With your park rental you are only renting the shelter.



We have fields available for basketball, tennis, soccer, baseball or softball. Lisle Community Park, Surrey Ridge Athletic Complex, Woodglenn Park, and River Road Park are available to rent.



Located in Community Park next to a walking trail and nestled near the Community Park pond, the stage is ideal for special events, small gatherings, or wedding ceremonies.



GARDEN PLOTS

Do you love to garden but don't have the space? We can help! Grow your own fresh, organic produce by renting a garden plot! Located on the south side of River Road Park, 5510 River Road in Lisle, each plot measures 10' x 15'. Gardeners have a choice between plots tilled by Lisle Park District staff or plots that they can till themselves. Adjacent plots cannot always be guaranteed. Water is not supplied - gardeners are required to bring water to water their own plots. Garden plots require a \$50 security deposit. This deposit is refundable if gardener follows all rules and regulations.

PROGRAM CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

Cancellation of programs is made three days prior to the program start date, whenever possible. In the event that the Park District cancels a program, the participant will receive a full refund. If a program is cancelled in mid-session, a prorated refund will be issued.

No refunds will be made once a program has begun unless the Park District has altered or cancelled a program, or if the "Satisfaction Guaranteed" policy is implemented. If you need to drop-out of a program there will be a service fee of \$5 to cover the cost of processing a refund. The Park District must be notified of cancellation by the register by (Reg. By) date for that program. Cancellations made after the register by (Reg. By) date are subject to a \$5 service fee, plus any costs incurred by the park district. Cancellations made with less than a 24-hour notice will not be able to receive a refund.

SATISFACTION GUARANTEED

The Lisle Park District is committed to providing the best quality programs to our participants. If you are not completely satisfied with the program after the first class, just give us a call. We will send you a "Dissatisfied Refund Form" to be filled out and returned, and after review, we can either provide you a credit that can be applied to another program or issue you a full refund. It is that easy. Satisfaction Guarantee does not apply to trips and special events.

Why are we doing this? We want all of our participants to get their money's worth from our programming. We are convinced that what we offer is of the highest quality, and we back that with a guarantee. Your comments and suggestions are valued.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Are you looking for some help to pay for programs? The Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation supports the mission of the Lisle Park District and recognizes the need within the community to provide assistance to residents who otherwise cannot afford to participate in Park District programs. This financial assistance program is funded by the Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation who annually provide up to \$12,000 in scholarship funds for Lisle Park District families who exhibit a financial need for assistance in order to enroll in recreational programming through the Lisle Park District.

- The waiver of program fees is available to Lisle Park District residents only. All programs are eligible for assistance.
- Income eligibility for Lisle Park District's waiver of program fees is based on the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services Poverty Guidelines.
- An applicant must supply the Lisle Park District with documentation of any forms of income he or she is currently receiving i.e. recent pay stub, AFDC case #, a copy of a recent IRS 1040 form, etc.
- Each eligible individual may apply the fee waiver to register for any park district program with a limit of \$750 per year for up to a family of four, with additional funding of \$190 per year for each additional child. This program is funded by the Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation. Funding is subject to availability of funds.
- A waiver of program fees may be issued for 6 months, but the applicant must reapply at the end of the time frame granted in order to continue participation in the program.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for financial assistance you will need to fill out our application, briefly describe what makes you and/or your family eligible, a list of the recreational programs that are of interest to you and/or your family, and a list all the persons living in your home for whom you provide support.

Complete application in its entirety

Attach proof of residency

Include documentation (i.e. pay stub, AFDC case #, copy of IRS 1040 form)

Complete program registration form and attach to application

Please allow 7 days for review of this application. Lisle Park District reserves the right to approve partial funding or deny an applicant's request.

All information on the application must be true and accurate.

Please fill out the assistance or accommodations section during online registration or on our registration form on page 97. Requests include but are not limited to: Inclusion Aides, Sign Language Interpreters, Adaptive Equipment, and Accessible Transportation.
- Parent/guardian will be contacted within 48 hours of registration to discuss and determine level of support needed. We will do our very best, but we can't guarantee an aide will be secured prior to the program start date.
- If we are able to secure an aide, SEASPAR (South East Association for Special Parks & Recreation) or the Park District will contact you.




