Lisle Park District Presented with Bus for Senior Programs

On March 24, 2011 Navistar announced its plans to partner with the Lisle Park District in providing a new bus for senior trip programs. Many residents participating in the senior trip scheduled for that day attended the presentation ceremony and were delighted to preview the new bus.

Present for the event was Doris Grillo, a decade-long Lisle resident and frequent senior trip attendee. "I am excited that the new bus is bigger and that the ride will be smoother. The overhead bins will be wonderful for our 'resaling trips' and with additional seating I hope less people will have to be put on a waiting list. This bus is a great benefit to the senior trip programs and we appreciate Navistar partnering with the Lisle Park District."

A Lisle resident since 1975, Evelyn Horejsi also attended the bus presentation. "As a retiree, I work my schedule around the Lisle Park District's senior trips – this month I am going on eight different outings. This bus is a dream come true! We will have more functional space with room for packages and we won't have to store items on our laps. I am very proud of the senior programming at the park district and looking forward to the exciting trips on our new bus."

Navistar sees this unique public-private partnership as an opportunity to provide a transportation solution to the park district while helping meet the needs of their constituents. The bus being presented to the park district is an IC Bus HC Series Platinum, which seats 31 passengers and has air conditioning and an audio and video system.
