Lisle, IL – Looking for a creative outlet to channel your inner artist? Take advantage of our new drop-in program, Art on a Cart!

The Lisle Park District is now offering this indoor studio art program at the Lisle Recreation Center at 1925 Ohio Street, Lisle. Every Thursday, from 3-5pm, now through December 26, 2019, the Art on a Cart program will provide creative, indoor art-making experiences for all ages. A variety of individual and group art activities are planned for each week, with the park district providing materials like chalk pastels, acrylic paint, crayons, colored pencils, markers, and newly added free-range art materials such as clay, bead art, yarn, and mini canvasses.

While children and adults are all welcome, a supervising adult should accompany children under 15. No pre-registration is necessary, but participants can call the Recreation Center at 630-964-3410 for more information and to register. Resident and nonresident fee for the program is \$5 and \$7 and can be paid at the door. Can't make it on Thursday nights?
