Lisle Park District Facilities Hiring Seasonal Staff

Lisle, IL – Looking for a summer job? With a number of facilities hiring for seasonal positions, Lisle Park District has great opportunities for teens and adults alike.

Sea Lion Aquatic Park, located at 1825 Short Street, Lisle, is a good option for both high school and college students looking for work this summer. Candidates should be at least 16 years old for positions ranging from Concession Stand Cashier, to Lifeguard or Swim Lesson Instructor. Training is required and will be provided by the park district for anyone hired, and typically takes place mid-May. All applicants should be available for flexible hours during the summer, including weekends. Park District Facilities Maintenance is also hiring for seasonal pool maintenance and operator positions. Another option for those looking to work outside this summer is with the Parks Department (1820 Short Street, Lisle). Seasonal Grounds Workers, as well as Seasonal Athletic Field Maintenance Workers are needed in shifts from March through mid October, or June through August. For more information, these positions are also listed at lisleparkdistrict.org/jobs, where interested candidates can submit their application.

For those who enjoy working with kids and teens, our camps are hiring counselors for the summer season. Ages 21 and up can apply to be a Camp Counselor with No Name Teen Camp, which meets Monday through Friday and goes on three field trips per week. Applicants must be available for training and planning beginning the week of May 27; the camp itself runs June 3 through August 9. All available camp and recreation positions can be found at lisleparkdistrict.org/jobs.

Open positions, both seasonal and permanent, across all Lisle Park District facilities are listed on our website, where anyone wishing to be considered for a position must apply.
