All ages are welcome to participate in this amusing special event, which will award prizes to those who float and sink!

Put your engineering caps on and grab a friend to create a team of 2 crewmembers per boat. Get creative to waterproof your cardboard vessel but make sure to follow the guidelines in the registration form and waiver available for download at LisleParkDistrict.org/specialevents, which must be completed by each team and crewmember. Registration is open through Saturday, July 30, by calling 630-964-3410 or visit the Lisle Park District Recreation Center at 1925 Ohio Street. Fee per boat is \$20 for residents and \$30 for nonresidents.

Don't forget to wear your swimsuit for the main event and be prepared to compete against other teams for one of six prizes, including Pride of the Regatta – most spectacular boat entry; Best Dressed – most creative team costumes; Team Spirit – most spirited team; Titanic Award – most valiant effort to keep boat afloat while sinking; 1st Place Race Winners; Battleship Winner. On Saturday, August 6, boat check-in begins at 9am followed by pre-race voting at 9:30am. The races start at 10am, and battleships launch at 10:30am.
