On Saturday, August 25, from 12:30-3:30pm, The Museums at Lisle Station Park has partnered with Alter Brewing Company in Downers Grove to bring you a new, exclusive 21+ event that will begin with picking hops at the museum campus and end at Alter's tasting room with a refreshing, uniquely crafted pint.

Harvesting History will start at The Museums at Lisle Station Park, 921 School Street in Lisle, where you'll learn how to tell when hops are ready to be picked and harvest some from the museum's very own four-square garden. Then, you'll discover some other uses for hops throughout history and how taverns came to be, including the Beaubien Tavern on the museum's campus, which was built in the 1830s.

Next, you'll be transported on the museum's bus over to Alter Brewing Company in Downers Grove to tour the brewery and drop off the freshly harvested hops for use in a brand new beer! You will learn how to taste beer from the brew masters, sample a few of their unique craft beers, and have time to enjoy a pint in their tasting room. There will be two return shuttles to The Museums at Lisle Station Park, the first at 3:00pm and the second at 3:30pm. Reserve your spot now to help cultivate this new collaboration between history and the vibrant culture of craft beer, as space on the bus is limited. The Museums at Lisle Station Park are conveniently located at 921 School Street in Lisle within walking distance of the Lisle Metra Station. Free parking is available on-site, at the Lisle Village Hall, and in the Lisle Metra train commuter parking lots on weekends and after 2:00pm on weekdays. Daily admission to the museum is free, and tours are available by appointment.
