### THE DIRECTOR

With another year almost behind us, this is an opportune time to reflect on our collective successes of 2025 while also looking forward to a constructive and collaborative 2026.

Our team continues to refer to the District's Strategic Master Plan and ongoing community engagement to drive the evolution of our services. As examples, our cultural arts and enrichment offerings have significantly expanded with new art and nature classes. Our Gentle Learning Preschool classrooms are at capacity for the 2025-26 school year reflecting an increase of almost 30% over last school year. And the popularity of our various camps continues to climb with an increase of over 200 participants from 2024. We have enjoyed this positive reaction and increased participation, and we attribute this to the community providing valuable, ongoing feedback and your Lisle Park District team responding in kind.

Looking ahead to 2026, much of the District's focus will be on more community engagement regarding indoor recreation space. As you likely know, the number one "Big Move" reported in the park district's 2023 Strategic Master Plan is to "Develop additional indoor, multigenerational recreation space." Much of 2025 was spent on developing an Indoor Recreation Space Feasibility Study which included additional community engagement by way of focus groups and surveys, an analysis of our existing spaces and limitations, and opportunities for program and indoor facility expansion based on the reported needs of the community. The final report was presented to the Board of Park Commissioners on Thursday, November 6 and adopted by the Board on November 13. A copy of the presentation and final report can be found by visiting the project-specific webpage HERE.

In summary, it was reported that there is strong public support for new indoor recreation spaces, and it is recommended the District continue to move forward with the process of a conceptual design of a facility with courts, indoor walking/jogging track, fitness/wellness spaces, etc. So, throughout the next several months, we will be conducting more detailed community engagement to review and critique conceptual facility designs, construction costs, estimated tax impact, etc.

In closing, please stay tuned to the Lisle Park District though social media, email subscription, etc., and look for opportunities to participate in sharing your opinions on additional indoor recreation program space. 

### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

FOR LISLE PARK DISTRICT PROGRAMS

Are you looking for some help to pay for programs? The Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation supports the mission of the Lisle Park District and recognizes the need within the community to provide assistance to residents who otherwise cannot afford to participate in Lisle Park District programs. This financial assistance program is funded by the Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation who provide scholarship funds for Lisle Park District families who exhibit a financial need for assistance in order to enroll in recreational programming.

- The waiver of program fees is available to Lisle Park District residents only. All programs are eligible.
- Income eligibility for Lisle Park District's waiver of program fees is based on the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services Poverty Guidelines.
- An applicant must supply the Lisle Park District with documentation of any forms of income he or she is currently receiving i.e. recent pay stub, AFDC case #, a copy of a recent IRS 1040 form, etc.

Each eligible individual may apply the fee waiver to register for any park district program with a limit of \$750 per year for up to a family of four, with additional funding of \$190 per year for each additional

- tional funding of \$190 per year for each additional child. This program is funded by the Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation. Funding is subject to availability of funds.
- A waiver of program fees may be issued for 6 months, but the applicant must reapply at the end of the time frame granted in order to continue participation.

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

To be considered for financial assistance you will need to fill out our application, briefly describe what makes you and/or your family eligible, a list of the recreational programs that are of interest to you and/or your family, and a list all the persons living in your home for whom you provide support.

To request special accommodations or assistance, follow the steps below:

- Early registration along with a request for ADA accommodation or inclusion assistance in any program is required at the time of registration and at least two weeks prior to the program start date.
- Please fill out the assistance or accommodations section during online registration or on our registration form. Requests include but are not limited to: Inclusion Aides, Sign Language Interpreters, Adaptive Equipment, and Accessible Transportation.
- Parent/guardian will be contacted within 48 hours of registration to discuss and determine level of support needed. We will do our very best but can't guarantee an aide will be secured prior to the program start date.
- If we are able to secure an aide, SEASPAR (South East Association for Special Parks & Recreation) or the Park District will contact you.

We apologize for any inconvenience these adjustments may cause. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated.

# REGISTER BY DATES HOW TO AVOID LATE FEES

The register by (Reg. By) date indicates the last day registration will be taken for programs. Any registrations accepted after the register by (Reg. By) date will be charged a \$5 late fee, unless otherwise noted.

#### **PROOF OF RESIDENCY**

A Lisle Park District resident applies to those persons residing within the boundaries of the Lisle Park District, as well as immediate family members living within that household. The fees listed in this brochure are for Lisle Park District Residents (R) & Nonresidents (NR).

You MUST show proof of residency with a photo ID along with a tax bill, lease or utility bill in-person at:

#### **NON-SUFFICIENT FUNDS**

There will be a \$25 service charge assessed for all electronic funds transfer (EFT) and checks returned for non-sufficient funds.

# PROGRAM CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

The Park District reserves the right to cancel, postpone or combine classes, or change instructors. Programs that do not reach the minimum enrollment numbers will be cancelled. Cancellation of programs is made three days prior to the program start date, whenever possible. In the event that the Park District cancels a program, the participant will receive a full refund. If a program is cancelled in mid-session, a prorated refund will be issued.

No refunds will be made once a program has begun unless the Park District has altered or cancelled a program, or if the "Satisfaction Guaranteed" policy is implemented. If you need to drop-out of a program there will be a service fee of \$5 to cover the cost of processing a refund. The Park District must be notified of cancellation by the register by (Reg. By) date for that program. Cancellations made after the register by (Reg. By) date are subject to a \$5 service fee, plus any costs incurred by the park district. Cancellations made with less than a 24-hour notice will not be able to receive a refund.

#### SATISFACTION GUARANTEED

The Lisle Park District is committed to providing the best quality programs to our participants. If you are not completely satisfied with the program after the first class, just give us a call. We will send you a "Dissatisfied Refund Form" to be filled out and returned, and after review, we can either provide you a credit that can be applied to another program, or issue you a full refund. It is that easy. Satisfaction Guarantee does not apply to trips and special events.

Why are we doing this? We want all of our participants to get their money's worth from our programming. We are convinced that what we offer is of the highest quality, and we back that with a guarantee. Your comments & suggestions are valued.




